#### 1. PERSONAL DATA

Personal data is information about a specific or identifiable person, in plain text all information that can be assigned to you individually, in particular: Your name, address, telephone number and email address.

#### 2. ACCESS DATA/ SERVER LOG FILES

When you visit this website, our web server temporarily saves every access in a log. This is only done for statistical purposes to enable the use of the website and primarily for technical administration, namely error identification and troubleshooting. A personal reference is generally not established, but cannot be completely ruled out. Until automatic deletion after evaluation, the following data is collected, stored and used at most:

- IP address
- Access date and time
- Name and URL of the retrieved data
- Amount of data transferred
- Message as to whether the retrieval was successful
- Data of the browser used, in particular type and version
- Data of the operating system used, in particular type and version
- Website from which the access was made
- Name of your provider

The data will not be passed on to third parties without your consent.

Data will not be passed on to state institutions and authorities, except within the framework of mandatory national legislation. Data will not be passed on to third parties beyond this or for other purposes.

### 4 COOKIES

So-called temporary cookies are used when individual pages are called up. Cookies are text files on your computer that are used to archive information for a limited period of time; they typically contain data on websites visited.
